C	Burratino - servant, "always let your conscience be your guide"
D O	Il Capitano - braggart soldier, mask has facial hair
E	Il Dattore - pompous doctor, mask highlights his fleshy nose
F	Pagliaccio - clown, mask represents one side of Dionysus
G	Pantalone - old merchant, usually has a hooked nose and beard
H 339	Pedrolino - trusting and naive servant, emotional character

I	Pulcinella - intelligent servant, wears a black mask with "pullus gallinaceus"
K	La Ruffiana - witch, mask with a bad hair day
L	Scaramuccia - boastful coward, wears a smooth black velvet mask
